Athletics

A chance for pupils to try a range of track and field events, including running, jumping and throwing. Sessions focus on building skills, fitness and confidence in a supportive setting.

Awesome Artists In The Wild!

In this fun outdoor club with Mrs Hodgkiss, you'll learn about different artists and techniques, while exploring colours and materials. Each session ends with a story about a famous painting or inspirational artist.

Ballet (R-Y1)

This class is filled with imaginative ways of learning fundamental ballet steps. The pre-primary and primary examination syllabus focuses on steps such as plies, battement tendus, skips, galops, pony canter, sautés, marching and rises. The focus is on developing the children's confidence, creativity, imagination, musical awareness and co-ordination whilst having fun.

Ballet (Y2-3)

This class combines foundation technique and performance skills in a wonderfully creative and enjoyable atmosphere. Pupils follow a slightly more structured format than in Reception to Year 1, with more exciting foundation steps being added to their dance vocabulary. The enjoyable and positive learning atmosphere allows for pupils to continue building their creativity, musical awareness and self-confidence.

Block Printing

In this creative and hands-on club, children will explore the art of block printing using both traditional and homemade printing blocks. They'll have the chance to design and print on fabric and card, creating beautiful take-home items such as greeting cards, tea towels, and bags. This club is a fantastic way for children to develop their artistic skills, experiment with patterns and colours, and enjoy the satisfaction of making something unique and personal.

Colour, Stitch & Print

A creative art club using paint, drawing print making and a bit of sewing packed with a whole bunch of creativity.



Comic & Chess

Love comics? Join Comic Club and dive into a world of superheroes, stories, and creativity! Whether you enjoy reading, drawing, or inventing your own characters, this is the place to bring your ideas to life! You will also have the opportunity to learn or develop your chess skills against our Chess Master, Mr Denis.

Construction

Give your child the chance to build big ideas, and explore their creativity using LEGO, wooden blocks and so much more! Each session involves problem solving, team work and imagination as children design towers, bridges, vehicles and anything else they can dream up themselves. Cricket

They will use avatar creation websites, Pivot stick figure animation, Scratch programming, web generators and AI. The aim is to give children the opportunity to use technology in ways that they might not be able to during their regular Computing lessons.
